Safeguarding Vulnerable Adults

This one day course will help you understand your safeguarding role and responsibilities when working with vulnerable adults. You will learn about the 10 types of abuse and how to recognise the signs and symptoms and how to raise and report your concerns, 'Safeguarding is Everybody's Responsibility'.

This course will cover:

- How the Care Act (2014) defines safeguarding duties and responsibilities
- The 6 Principles of safeguarding
- The types of abuse and their indicators
- Raising concerns and reporting
- Raising concerns about a person in a position of trust



- Consent and information sharing
- Promoting well-being
- Balancing wellbeing and risk

Volunteer Management

This one day course will cover the fundamentals of working with volunteers and managing the process of recruiting, processing and supporting volunteers in your settings.

- Dealing with difficult situations and problems
- Celebrating success

This course will be delivered as a webinar but will include activities and an opportunity to interact with the trainer and other participants.

Marketing

Developing a Social Media Strategy – delivered by ISE, this will be a 2 hour online session. A practical workshop exploring the functionality of popular social media platforms and how to make them work within the capacity of your group. Using real examples you will discover your social media style and learn how to develop a digital social media strategy that engages and connects with your audience.

Wednesday 20th January 2021, 2.00pm to 4.00pm

Developing a Communications Strategy – delivered by ISE, this will be a 2 hour online session. "We do so many good things, but no one knows what!" Sound familiar? Community groups often have great stories, but why is it they sometimes struggle to tell them? In this workshop we tackle what we mean by 'effective communications' and look at how we can get our good stories out there. We explore how to prioritise communications within the resources we have, developing a practical, action-focussed communications strategy that works for you.
